Dear Parent:

We are excited to announce beginning February 1, 2012, you will be able to put money on your child's meal account over the Internet, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, using PayForIt.net and a personal credit card or debit card. This service benefits schools, parents, and students. Cashiers will spend much less time taking deposits at the serving line, parents do not have to worry about the money not reaching school, and students never have to worry about not having money to pay for lunch. However, if you choose not to use PayForIt.net, the District will continue to accept cash and checks at each school cafeteria.

Here's how to use this new service. Log onto [www.payforit.net](http://www.payforit.net) and you can easily do the following:

- Set up an account;
- Deposit money at your convenience;
- Set email reminders to notify you when your child's account gets low;
- Set up recurring payments;
- Check your child's balance, at no cost; and
- Request an activity report so you can see what your child has eaten in the previous thirty (30) days.

To set up an account, you will need the following:

- Your child's first and last name exactly as it appears in the school district's student management system and your child's student identification number. (This information can be obtained by contacting your child's school);
- A valid email address; and
- A credit card or debit card.

Each child in your family can be set up on the same account. Once money is placed on the account, it typically appears in your child's account within two hours or less.
