

INITIAL ENTRANT SCREENING NOTIFICATION

All children within sixty (60) administrative working days of initial enrollment in a public school shall be screened in the following areas to determine if formal assessment is indicated:

- 1) Speech, voice and language: (Speech Therapist) and
- 2) Vision and hearing (Nurse/ Speech Therapist)

All children (through grade three), within sixty (60) administrative working days of initial enrollment in public schools, shall be screened for fine and gross motor functions to determine if formal assessment is indicated. (Physical Education Teacher)

The regulation addressed above applies to the following students:

- 1) A student enrolling in our school system for the first time, such as kindergarten;
- 2) One who has transferred to the public school from a private, home or parochial school unless a comparable evaluation report is available from the former school;
- 3) One who is transferring from another public school within Virginia unless, through a review of records, it is determined that the student has been screened previously;
- 4) One who is transferring from another state.
